



## **Call for Service: Midshore Intergroup Needs AA Volunteers**

The Midshore Intergroup is actively seeking AA members to participate in crucial service work. Our mission is to extend a helping hand to alcoholics who are struggling and in need of support, guiding them towards a path of recovery. Service work also enhances our sobriety and our programs through the mission of carrying the message.

### **Assist with the 12-Step Call List**

We are particularly in need of volunteers to assist with the 12-step call list. When an alcoholic reaches out for help by phone, the intergroup office or answering service connects them to AA members on our 12th step list who are willing to be there for newcomers in their area, provide AA information, and offer to meet them at a meeting.

### **Bridging the Gap (BTG)**

When alcoholics are released from treatment facilities, they need a temporary contact as a link between treatment and recovery. The BTG coordinator will reach out to you with the name of the alcoholic who is requesting AA help. You will then connect with the alcoholic and introduce them to AA in the area.

### **Support in Treatment Facilities**

Individual AA women, men, and home groups are needed to carry the message to alcoholics in treatment centers by bringing AA meetings into the centers. As an AA member, you will share your experience, strength, and hope just as you would at a typical AA meeting. If transportation is an issue, please reach out to the treatment committee for assistance.

### **Support in Correctional Facilities/Detention Centers**

Individual AA women, men, and home groups are needed to carry the message to alcoholics in jails, detention centers or correctional facilities by bringing AA meetings on a regular basis. As an AA member, you will share your experience, strength, and hope just as you would at a typical AA meeting.
